Variety

Red grapes blend (45% Malbec, 25% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Cabernet Franc, 10% Petit Verdot).

Vineyard location

Agrelo, Luján de Cuyo, Mendoza.

Vinification

Harvest at optimal ripening. Micro vinification, 50% in new French oak barrels of each varietal separately, and the 50% resting in stainless steel tanks using selected indigenous yeast.

Aging

24 months in artisanal barrels of 350 liters of three different types of oaks: French, German and Austrian of first use.

Selection

This wine is obtained from a selection of the best parcels of our vineyard in Agrelo, of the best varietals and barrels of every year.

Tasting notes

Color: deep red. Aromas: very complex nose reminiscent of red and black fruits, white and black pepper, licorice, menthol, eucalyptus and finely roasted aromas of coffee, tobacco and chocolate. Mouth: intense and silky entry. Complex flavors of plum, raspberry and currant along with spices such as pepper and anise. Unctuous wine with great personality and elegance.
